
INFO FRONT

This time he broke three or four bones in his foot whilst riding his motorcycle with Eddie and Martin. Can you say bummed? Woody can . . . Marty Schlesinger, who broke his shoulder just before the first 2-Hip contest in Minnesota (his home state), just crashed on the Camarillo ramp and crunched a couple of ribs—one of them puncturing a lung in the process. But he's recuperating and expected to ride in the Oregon Masters contest (next issue) . . . No fun for these two.

Team changes happen constantly for one reason or another, so we report on them . . . The biggie this month is in the team manager department. After a few highly successful years with CW, Mr. Harold McGruther, aka McGoo, Hal, Hank, etc., has moved himself over to the GT offices. A major change indeed. McGoo moves over to handle the likes of White, Fiola, Aparijo, DeLuca, Voelker, Maes, Hernandez, and a host of others. MAES? Ceppie Maes? On Dyno? Could be. It seems Ceppie has decided he can't stay away from freestyle—he's rumored to have been talking live with GT's Shawn Buckley recently. Hmmm. So what about CW you say? Without the blink of an eve. BMX legend Mike Miranda has stepped into McGoo's shoes as the CW tour guy/den mother. Quite a change for those three. Good luck to you all . . . Long time GT/Dyno rider Chris Lashua has moved over to Mongoose. As far as Lashua's GT/Mountain Dew Trick Team goes, the name has been changed to the Mountain Dew Freestyle Performance Team and the riders are now allowed to ride for whomever they want, although Mongoose is helping out a few of them now. The team riders are still Dennis Langlais, and Greg Macomber, PLUS the likes of two new guys-Scott Morony and Glen Gollrad . . . One of the baddest ground riders you'll ever see, Chris Day, is off the Dyno team for undisclosed reasons. Could it have something to do with him showing up at the

Florida Masters when he wasn't supposed to? ... That infamous Redondo local. Mike Tokemoto is back on Hanter-oops. I mean Visage. Camarillo's Doug Randazzo is also on the team now, AND, they've added Zorlac skater Todd Prince for their summer tour, which will include a portable half-pipe . . . Female contortionist freestyler Krys Dauchy is riding under the GT banner as of this moment-not Haro as was first reported. A first in freestyle history. Congrats Krys . . . Last month's Undergrounders Paul Mackles and Carl Marquardt are getting help from Mongoose. Cool . . . And while we're on sponsorships we might as well tell you about General's new co-sponsorship deal. Go to your nearest General dealer and talk to them about getting on. If you make it (only five riders per shop accepted). General supplies you with a jersey, I.D. card, a performance diary that you send to General every month, and (this is the good part) half off on any General bike, PLUS the chance you might get picked up full factory. Sounds cool-keep in mind General has about 2,500 dealers around the U.S. . . . Keep your eyes peeled for a new grip to be out soon-the Jive Handle. It's BAD.

This year the AFA will try and shut up all the guys who complain about the ramps being different from contest to contest. AFA sponsor, Dia-Compe paid for the construction of a new steel framed quarter—built by Texas AFA affiliate Scott Patterson—that will be transported to every Masters Series this year. A good idea come to life. Let's just hope the quarter-pipe is a good one . . . ODI, the maker of Mushroom grips, has a new thing going with their sponsored riders-limited edition, collectors' signature series grips. The six freestylers due to have grips released in their names are Wilkerson, Dominguez, Blyther, Blood, El Cid, and McCoy. Only 5,000 of each signature grip will be made before the molds will be broken-meaning these things could become collector's items for all you grip collectors. And watch for the above mentioned pros to be giving away A LOT of ODI stickers because each one was given 5,000 signature stickers to throw into tosses everywhere . . . What's this we hear about Swatch doing shows at Sun City in South Africa? Yeah, yeah, and they sent Todd Anderson and semi-famous

ANDY: "I heard a rumor that Leroy has a wooden leg and that you learned all your tricks from him (laughter).

WOODY: "Ceppie told a bunch of kids that in Alabama last year. But no. Leroy has both his legs and I got both of mine.'

ON TO THE READER QUESTIONS . . .

'Now let's get things straight once and for all—what is your real name? I've heard Derwood, Woodard, Joe, Edwin, etc. -Will Chamberlain, Hugo, Minnesota

WOODY: "My real name as it reads on my birth certificate is Joseph Derwood Itson. But all my credit cards and everything else says Woody. My brother for some reason started calling me Woody after some detective movie or something. And when I grew up I didn't want to be a Joe.

Have you ever broken any bones freestyling? - John Martinez, Lincoln Park, Michigar

WOODY: "No. Knocked a tooth out once but never broke any bones . . . freestyling that is."

Do you ride motorcycles?' -John Martinez, Lincoln Park, Michigan

WOODY: "(laugher) Yeah, I ride motorcycles. I have this problem though, I can't go out there and just ride a motorcycle, I have to do freestyle on it and jump it. It's funny though, because this time I got hurt and I wasn't doing anything, I was just going in a straight line and Martin cut over on me, I hit his back wheel and flipped over doing about 45 or 50. Right when I hit the ground I knew. I just laid there and my foot hurt SO bad. They had to cut my boot off when I got to the hospital. (Ed. note: the crash happened just four days before this interview and the day after the photos were shot.) I broke all five bones just behind my toes straight across."

"Do you ever freestyle on your own when it has nothing to do

with the Diamond Back team?" -Mike Lesinki, Depew, New York WOODY: "That's all I do. I

don't even worry about calling anybody up to ride. Scotty Freeman is about the only person I ride with that's got a name. Most of the guys I ride with are the kids in my neighborhood and they're just as good as any of the guys at the national contests. I taught them most of what they know but now they're getting to the point where they're starting to teach me some stuff."

'Who's your most respected rival?" —Chris Shubert, Whitehouse, Ohio

WOODY: "Uhm, well probably the guy to beat right now is Dennis McCoy. He's won the most so far."

'Have you got any heros?'' —Yo Yin Mak, Queens, New York

WOODY: "Superman, If I could fly, that would be the best. Him and Bruce Lee. He was good at what he did. And Chuck Norris. I like martial arts a lot. I think people that get to the point that they can be that rad . . . that 's awesome I took martial arts a few years back. It's fun, I messed around with some of the weapons and stuff but that was many years ago."

'Are you a Ninja?'' —Omar ''The Elven Boy" Cuellar, the Space Chicken Freestyle Team, Miami, Florida

WOODY: "(laughter) No. I've ridden one but I'm not one."

'If you were at a contest and everyone was riding at their best, who do you think would win pro flat and ramps?" -Mike Scott, Cazadero, California

WOODY: "If they gave it a five to six minute time limit I could win easy, just 'cause I wouldn't be runnin' out of tricks. There are a few good guvs in there, R.L., Dennis-they could win at anytime. In pro ramp if everyone was at their best . . . Michael. Nobody can touch him. But there are like three or four guys in each class that I think could win at any time. Wilkerson is bad on a ramp. Blyther is really good too But I think all those guys are going to be a little nervous when Hoffman turns pro."

'What was the biggest high in your career? The biggest low?" Norman deDios, New Haven, Connecticut

WOODY: "The biggest low is probably now, having this kind of an injury. That and losing my first contest, which was the AFA

finals in Manchester, New Hampshire (FREESTYLIN' May '86), when I dislocated a bone in my foot and I rode the last three and a half minutes of my routine that way-and no back brakes."

"I guess one of the biggest highs was a long time ago when everyone was talking about the pros being afraid to ride contests-they were talking about me and Martin and R.L., saving we were afraid to get beat. Then I rode the Venice Beach contest (FREESTYLIN' November '85) and showed them how afraid I was-I won. It's good to win contests. But signing with Diamond Back was really probably the best thing that's ever happened to me.

'Over the years has your attitude towards freestyle changed at all?" -Ben Jordan. Williamsburg, Virginia

WOODY: "I guess a little bit. At first I was in it for all fun-there was no sport. Then after a while I became what they call real estate-I was worth something. So I had to start thinking 'I gotta do this, I gotta do that, I gotta do this.' I got very business oriented. But over the last year I've gotten back to where I like to ride my bike-there doesn't have to be magazines or it doesn't have to be a contest. To me, freestyle is just riding around in the streets and doing shows. I would rather do shows than contests."

"Do you still have your tonsils?" -Mike Tome, Salamanca, New York

WOODY: "Yeah. Still got my appendix too. Wanna buy it (laughter)"

'What do you think about drugs?'' —William Trimble, Orlando, Florida

WOODY: "I've never taken them so I can't comment on them. I don't drink either. I figure that if that's what you want to do then you're gonna do it-I'm not one to preach about it but I think it's wrong. I've done a lot of 'Sav No To Drugs' stuff on TV in the past. But I do have to take pain pills for my foot (laughter)."

"What do you consider the most useless thing in the world besides a freewheel?" -Jeff Masse, Chicopee, Maryland

WOODY: "Good question. Levers on your handlebars for bar rides (laughter). That and the cotton on the top of Tylenol hottles'

"Have you ever been in a commercial? What movies have you appeared in?" -Mike Tome and

the Rolling Rebels, Salamanca, New York

WOODY: "Yeah. One (laughter). I did a Murray commercial for a freestyle bike about two years ago and it showed around Christmas time. It was for the X20 Freestyle bike. Awesome. It ran for about two months. As far as movies, I was in Body Rock-that was a real lemon-and Quicksilver, that was pretty good."

LEW: "What about TV?" WOODY: "Well I've been on like, Two On The Town, Eve On L.A., and That's Incredible . . . and the news a bunch of times. Oh yeah, I'm on the beginning of the David Brenner show every night too

'If freestyle was outlawed throughout the world and carried a "punishable by death' sentence, would you still ride?' -Scott Imrich, Danbury, Connecticut

WOODY: "I'd be dead."

Have you ever spiked your hair?" -R.J. Winsled, Tucson, Arizona

WOODY: "(laughter) No, but when we were on summer tour with Vans, Kele (Rosecrans) and Martin (Aparijo) poured bleach in the front of my hair so I had this big blond streak in the front. But never have I spiked it."

What's your opinion of freestyle competition? Like do you think it's a real test of skill or a bunch of crap?" —Scott Imrich

WOODY: "50/50. I think it leans more towards the crap as far as rules go. Because there ARE no official rules. Nobody can sit down and show me the rules. The rules are garbage. Contests are for manufacturers who what to put a label on a rider. They need to have riders in a jam session, that way you don't get real tired and you have time to think of your next trick-you get to keep it exciting that way too, because the people aren't just watching one guy for four minutes. They're going to see one guy after another and everybody is trying to top each other. That's a contest. But promoters are too into the 'let's get it done and get it over with' thing."

'Can you think of anything you want to talk about?" -Craig Cournoyer, Tacoma, Washington

WOODY: "Yeah, we've got a rad summer tour coming up. We got new posters, a new trailer. new ramps, everything is looking good-the only thing we're looking for is an announcer, sooo . . . And the fact that I'm gonna have my own bike coming out from Diamond Back soon is cool. Things are looking good. Hopefully I'll be getting into a house this year."

'Do you think Dan Hardy is cool?" Omar Cuellar, Miami, Florida

WOODY: "Who? Well, I don't know him personally, but it sounds like a good name.'


Any final comments, world destroying philosophy, or just plain stupid sayings for the readers?" —Jim Hultman, Tacoma, Washington WOODY: "Uhhh. Well . . . this

is when you're supposed to be humble huh? All the kids that bought Trick Stars, buy Diamond Backs. If you go motorcycle riding, don't go riding with Martin, he's dangerous, What else? To all the kids that still support me even though I haven't won all the last contests, I'd like to say thanks to them. I'll be out there this summer and I won't let you guys down. And also when I was off Hutch and between rides the people up at Rockville BMX were really good to me. So to Chuck and Brian and everyone else at Rockville, I want to say thanks a lot because they helped me through a hard time. And of course Rob at Peddlepower for driving me to the hospital. And all my co-sponsors for standing by me all these years. Other than that I hope I get this thing off my foot real soon."

Dena Dawler: "And he wants to tell all the girls in Texas to stop calling and writing (laughter).'



Chris Lashua is what we magazine-types refer to as a "subliminal rider". It seems like he's at every major contest, or always on tour, but he never gets noticed . . . until he starts riding. Jaws drop and "Who's THAT guy?" is the common reaction when people see his acute sense of showmanship, crowd pleasing variety, and weird power tricks. Rumor has it he does 200 push-ups a day to keep himself in top shape. Dedication like that lets you know he takes his freestyle seriously.


This month we decided to take a closer look at "Mr. Subliminal" by doing a Pro*File on him. Tricks were recorded on film and words were recorded on tape. The photos turned out great. But the tape . . . ahh, if you've ever used a micro-cassette recorder, then you know how easy it is to hit "record" instead of "rewind" (i.e. we blew it). The result was a blank tape and a black eye (just kidding). Anyways, to give you an idea of what Chris is about, we relied on memory. Here's some info you might not already know regarding Lashua:

He's 18 and BUSY. Being a fulltime student at the University of Boston doesn't leave him much time for other activities, but he manages to spend a few hours a day on a bike practicing. Crammed somewhere between studying and riding, he finds time to promote and book shows for his Mountain Dew Freestyle Performance Team, which he purchased from Ron Stebenne about a year ago.

Since he turned pro two years back at the AFA Finals in New Hampshire, things have been moving along steadily. He's now considered THE pro kingpin on the East Coast, and only a few weeks ago he left his long-time sponsor—Dyno, for a change of pace. His choice? Mongoose.

An interesting thing about Chris joining Mongoose . . . about a year ago, Rick Allison was in almost exactly the same situation as Chris is in now . . a guy who's been around for a while and is just waiting for his time to come. Halfway through last year Allison began to finish higher and higher at contests—now he can be counted on to finish in the top five at any given time. I wouldn't be surprised to see Lashua do the same.

He specializes in flatland, although at shows he's been known to occasionally hit the ramps. Right now he's too busy practicing for the pro



Just one of the many nameless tricks in Lashua's battery of flatland knowledge.


ground class to be worried about going for any overall wins.

He hates brake maintenance, holey grips, and negative attitudes. He likes riding, and is stoked to be on Mongoose. When he needs to take a break from mid-winter parking garage sessions, he'll terrorize the slopes on a snowboard. A different form of dual, indeed.

His goals are to further his success with the Mountain Dew Team and become recognized as a threat in the pro class. At this point his goals seem highly attainable.

Be on the lookout for Lashua in '87... we have a feeling his days as a "subliminal rider" are drawing to a close








congratulated and rewarded for his attempted bravery. You begin to slide out of



WE: "Who do you like to ride with at contests and stuff?"



HE: "Uhmm . . . let's see. Dennis McCoy didn't invent everything (laughter). Anybody who's just starting out shouldn't set their goals to become a




squeaker thing. We don't know what he calls it, but you can bet it's not easy.


FROM ONE RIDER TO ANOTHER

WORDS BY LEWMAN

t's a manufacturer's job to produce a product that the consumer will find appealing and useful. It's the media's job to report on the product, letting the consumer know the good and bad points. And it's the consumer's job to buy the product. You are a consumer. We are the media. Haro is one of many manufacturers. The Master is one of Haro's many products.

There are several means of analytically testing a product in a magazine, but we decided to ace those methods and just RIDE the thing. After all, that's what it all boils down to, right?

In '87 Haro took some BIG steps to better their freestyle line. New graphics, new geometry, new fork pegs, new chainstáy platforms, new brakes, a spinning device, and best of all . . . the same price (basically) as last year.

The steeper head angle (73 degrees) makes the rear end come off the ground easier, thus it's WAY smoother when you do stuff like squeakers, G-turns, fork wheelies, etc. Believe me, you can feel a difference. If the geometry on a bike is TOO steep, the steering is jerky—too fast. Ramp riders have a much more difficult time adjusting, too. The balance point on the Master is right in there.

In the Haro ads they claim the Master was designed for flatlanders . . . but don't let that stop you if you crave vert. A look at the new and improved fork pegs shows proof that the Master has dual capabilities. Just make sure you avoid letting any part of your body besides your feet touch the claw-like cages of the pegs . . . they're pretty toothy.

The rear of the bike has been given a facelift, too. New rear chainstay platforms that feature grippy little Shimano DX pedal-type studs on the tubing. It works like you wouldn't believe . . . too good in some cases. Sometimes it's difficult to get your feet off the platforms quickly if you wedge your foot in too tightly. Thread on a set of axle pegs and you'll no doubt agree that the pegs combined with the studs create the BEST standing area ever. It's also cool to see that the places where your feet are constantly going to be—the forks and rear triangle—have been chromed so you don't have to worry about messing up the sweet paint job. Trendy yet sano.

Another new-fangled item to adorn the tail section of the Master are the Dia-Compe 990 brakes. So far we've gotten mixed reviews about them. Everybody who had their brakes dialed in by someone who knows what they're doing LOVES the way the 990s stop. And everybody who had to struggle with them on their own thinks they're not worth the trouble. The advantages are that the brakes are supposedly more tucked out of the way (tell that to Dizz), and the calipers give you more leverage due to the cable routing. All I have to say is that I'm baffied and bewildered by the 990s. The set on our test bike seemed to work good, even with the stock pads on the nylon Tuff Wheels.

Tuff Wheels? Yes, Skyway originals. OR, 48s...you actually get to make a few choices if you decide to purchase a Master. You can get the standard Master with either Tuff Ils OR Peregrine 48s, and the Tuff Wheels are available in coaster brake or freewheel. Keep in mind that the bike with 48s is only available in blue, while the one with the Tuffs comes in your pick of either blue or red. AND there's also another version of the Master ... this one's called the Master Team, and is a duplicate bike to the ones Dennis McCoy and Dave Nourie ride—it costs around \$500.00, but that includes gems like the H.P. 48s, the three piece Peregrine cranks and sealed B.B., Aerial levers ... the works. Of course, for \$375.00, the standard Master is nothing to scoff at.

The only place where cost-cutting is evident on the whole bike is the pedals—semi-bogus plastic models that tend to be slippery when wet. Or sometimes even when dry. Shine the stock pedals and pick up something with a little more bite to it. Other than that, you're set.

An Odyssey Gyro, Dia-Compe 883s, and Haro tires are three items you can find on practically ANY true hardcore's bike, regardless of what brand he rides. All three products come stock on the Master. That should tell you something.

In case you haven't been adding up cost and figuring out the value of the Master as we go along . . . let me make it easy for you. From one rider to another, the Master is totally worth the 375-or-so dollars you'll be handing over to own one. And if you do own one, you'll find that everything we just discussed is true.

Okay, as the media, we've just done our job. Now it's up to YOU, the consumer, to let Haro (the manufacturer) know how well they've done their job. And in order to do that, you've gotta do your job, which is consume.


"Naaa, probably not. Haro's keeping the tours small this year, with more guys switching on and off."

He stopped riding for a moment and sat down to catch his breath and think. The halogen light from the overhead street lamps glinted off the chromed section of his forks, and he stared deeply into the glint. In it he saw the distorted reflection of a sweaty young man, staring open-mouthed at a pair of forks. Slowly the image began to twist, and soon his reflection had faded. The glint had taken on a new shape, and in it he saw himself riding. Rolling . . . rolling backwards. And a flash of movement—something flailing . . . or spinning.

He blinked, and his reflection re-appeared. Dumbfounded, he glanced uneasily from side to side, then directed his attention to the glint once more. A flash of the spinning thing . . . this time

he realized it was his bars. His feet . . . he saw his feet on the top tube, his calf muscles pinching the seat. A framestand. He now saw the whole chain of events unwind before him like an instant replay. Over and over, each time he noted foot positioning, timing, weight distribution. Each time the whole thing became clearer. He watched until he knew.

Rolling forward in a framestand, hands holding the grips. Turning in a slow counter-clockwise arc, leaning into the turn just slightly. A squeeze of the front brake lever brought his bike up into an endo as he pivoted 180 degrees on his front wheel. During this pivot, the calf muscles automatically tightened on his seat. As the rear wheel touched

down, all body weight was shifted to the rear triangle of the bike, and the handle-bars were thrown into a clockwise spin. Arms were extended out to the sides and used as balance. The bike completed a full 360 degree counterclockwise turn with the bars rapidly spinning in the opposite direction. Just as the bars began slowing down, knees were bent, weight was shifted forward, and hands found grips. After the hands clenched the grips, he dropped back down to the pedals. As he began to understand this new trick, a smile crept across his face.

Suddenly his world is disrupted by the sound of a running engine, and shining headlights broke his concentration. A two-tone sedan pulls up, radio crackling, spotlight probing.

"Hey son . . . isn't it a little late to be out here riding your bicycle?"


"Huh? Oh. Yeah, I guess so, officer. I was just sitting here."

With a nod of the head, the public servant is off in search of someone else to serve and protect, leaving him alone once more. He looks into the chromed fork blade and sees only his reflection.



It instantly became my favorite move. If you've been struggling with backside walkarounds as well as nursing leg wounds, study the next few paragraphs carefully. If you already know how to do the trick, why are you still reading this? Get out there and ride.

ONE: Make sure your back brakes work.

TWO: Roll forward with your feet on the rear chainstays. Pre-set your pedals so the crank arm on the right side is forward. Tap the front brakes to do an endo, and as soon as the rear wheel touches the ground you should already be removing your right foot from the platform.

THREE: Keep both brakes locked during the course of this trick or experience a new level of pain.


FOUR: Bring your right foot off the chainstay and up over the top tube, passing it in front of the seat. At the same time begin steering your bars to the right. Keep your weight centered over the bike as you pull it up vertically. Don't throw yourself off balance by swinging your body away from the bike-keep everything tight and as close to the bike as possible. Bring your right leg over the head tube and step heel-first onto the seat post mast. It's important that you stay directly over the head tube, because in this position the front end

will have a tendency to drop out from underneath you. Just as your right foot touches the seat post mast, push off the rear platform


with your left foot. FIVE: Hang tough, you're halfway there. Swing your left leg away from the bike and around the head tube. Keep turning the bars (imagine yourself "steering" through a decade). As your left leg makes it around the top tube, push off the seat post mast with your right foot and pull it out from inside the frame triangle. Twist your body around so that you'll be landing left foot first on the top tube-the bike will really start dropping fast at this point, so be quick about it. Your front

wheel should hit the ground just as you've finished "steering" the bike through the trick, thus the handlebars have been turned 360 degrees. All your weight will be on your left foot, which should be firmly planted on the top tube. Your right foot should be dangling real close to the right pedal, thus as soon as you land you'll be able to step on it and pedal

SIX: If you make it the first time, get extremely stoked. If you DON'T make it the first try, grit your teeth and try again.







Spinning and whirling across the dusty plains, a 300 foot tall funnel cloud can destroy anything in its path, its vortex constantly sucking in and spitting out debris.

Now imagine yourself doing the same thing the next time you ride with the homeys. No, not forming a 300 foot tall funnel cloud . . . imagine twisting and spinning with such a fury that any onlookers are left baffled. Grab some safety gear in case the G-forces get the best of you, and meet me out in the driveway in five minutes . . .

It helps to know boomerankles before you try a cyclone, but if you don't boomerankle, don't sweat it-these are actually a little easier. Start out rolling forward with both feet on the pedals at a slow speed. Tap your front brakes and hold them on while you begin your spin. Push upward off your pedals and tuck your knees into your chest as you swing your legs around the front of the bike in a clockwise fashion. Once your front wheel has turned 180 degrees or so, let off the brakes to give yourself some momentum. Do sort of a can-can with your right foot and land on the right fork peg. Swing your left leg all the way around and land on the right rear standing platform. You should now be coasting slowly in a clockwise circle, right foot on the right front peg, left foot on the right rear peg. Bring your right hand over to the left grip and grab onto it. Once you're in control with your right hand, remove your left hand and place it on the right grip. At the same time, take your right

foot from the front fork peg and transfer it to the pedals. As you shift your weight forward onto the right pedal. swing your left leg over the seat and onto the left pedal. Ride away seated, then switch your bars back to normal.

You now have one more to unleash on the unsuspecting public.













Each member of the crowd had paid eight dollars at the gate in order to have the privilege of sitting on the aluminum bleachers. The boy grinned, shaking his fist triumphantly in the air, and the boisterous cheering grew even louder.

The boy swung through another maneuver—again, the crowd responded with fury. Ronnie James Dio's "Rainbow in the Dark" blared. Judges frantically scribbled and calculated scores on mint green tablets. Time ticked by and greedy eyes watched from the sidelines, studying tricks and waiting for a mistake at the same time. But the boy was ON today. No mistakes would be made. The boy's whole routine took less than three minutes, not counting the time he had spent practicing for this day, which was a considerable amount.


The crowd was at the Velodrome. The guy with the yellow bullhorn was named Stan. The boy on the bike was a 17-year-old joker from Northern California named Karl Rothe. One of the many tricks he did that brought the crowd to a boil was the Karl kruzer. This is how he did it:

Start by hopping in the basic "I" formation (I-hops). Keep the front brakes locked and hold the seat firmly with your right hand. Drop down to the fork peg with your left foot and begin to squeak by pushing off the front tire with your right foot. Control and patience are the keys. Lean your weight slightly forward and keep a good grip on the seat or you'll get sketchy. Also, be sure and point the tail section of the bike away from you a bit so you don't clip it with your right foot when you begin squeaking.

Keep the side of your tire turned slightly outward by leaning into your turn. At first it will seem impossible, but you'll need to generate enough speed when you squeak to coast around in a circle. Lots of balance and practice is what it takes. Being Karl Rothe helps, but isn't mandatory.

Once you're rolling in a circle, hang your right leg waaaay back and milk your speed for all you're worth . . try to coast as far as possible. To pull out, let go of the seat with your right hand and grab the bars. The rear end of the bike will automatically swing into a half-tailspin, then fall back to the ground. Be ready to make any necessary corrections.

Once the back wheel makes contact with the ground, you'll be in a fork wheelie position. From here just swing your right leg over the top tube while you pivot on your front wheel, and you're back on the pedals where you started. No problem.
